





Why Sourcing Insulation Is Tricky

- Product grades vary
- Size options can be confusing
- International standards differ
- Inaccurate quotes waste time

Not All Insulation Is Created Equal






The Secret Behind Insulation Costs

- Composition affects performance
- Better materials = Higher cost, better efficiency
- Cheaper options may need frequent replacement

Standard vs. Custom Sizes

Standard	Custom
Lower MOQ Faster delivery Often more cost-effective	Higher MOQ Longer production time May increase overall cost



Standards Vary Widely

- Testing methodologies differ
- Performance criteria can be incompatible
- Compliance requirements are region-specific

Always specify your required standard and be prepared to conduct region-specific tests to ensure compliance and performance in your target market.

Test Reports Are Not Universal

- A product compliant in one region may fail in another
- Example: Fire resistance tests in EU vs. USA

Region-Specific Testing is Often Necessary

- Don't assume international equivalence
- Plan ahead for additional certification processes

- □ Exact specifications (dimensions, density)
- □ Quantity needed
- □ Intended usage
- □ Required quality standards
- □ Delivery requirements
